

GLOUCESTER SKATING CLUB

Daytime Competitive Training Sessions

From September to May/June

2:30 – 3:20 p.m. and 3:30 – 4:20 p.m.

These two sessions are open to single skaters, dance teams and pair teams who are part of the **GSC Competitive Team (Juvenile to Senior) and/or on the GSC Competitive Session** and will be attending the Eastern Ontario Sectional Championships. (From September through to EOS Sectionals)*

*After EOS Sectionals, the 2:30 - 3:20 p.m. session may be opened up to skaters at other levels (to be determined) if the ice is not being used at full capacity.

These sessions are sold as "Ticket Ice sessions"

1 single ticket = 1 session (50 minutes) or **1 double ticket** = 2 sessions (2 x 50 minutes)

Double Tickets are for two sessions on the same day and **cannot** be split into 2 different days.

Skaters who qualify for these sessions may use these tickets any day of the week (Monday to Friday) throughout the fall/winter/spring skating seasons.

How to purchase tickets

Tickets are purchased in increments of 10 through the fall/winter registration forms or from the Club office. Tickets must be paid for in advance (ticket purchases cannot be applied to skater accounts). Towards the end of the spring session (usually May 1st), the Club makes a special exception to allow tickets to be purchased individually from the Club office or skaters can sign the ticket ice book rink-side and their accounts will be charged.

Ticket Ice should be prepaid like other skating registrations, otherwise, a skater is supposed to pay the Guest Skate fee. Occasionally skaters will skate more than estimated in a given month causing an overdrawn balance. The Club will accept payment for overdrawn tickets at the Ticket Ice rate **provided** they are paid for in the first week of the following month. If additional tickets are not purchased in the first week of the month, the Guest Skate rate will be applied from the date tickets became overdrawn up to the date of the next purchase.

Note: Skaters from the same family cannot share tickets.

Ticket Ice Balances

In the first week of each month, the bookkeeper will send an invoice for ticket ice from the previous month and will note ticket ice balances. If an update is needed prior to the email, the skater can always check the ticket ice book when they sign in.

Tickets are non-refundable and must be used by the end of Pre-Summer school. Unused tickets can be carried forward from Fall school to Winter school and from Winter school to Pre-Summer School but they **cannot** be carried forward from Pre-Summer school to the next Fall school.
