For the Gloucester Skating Club to fulfil its vision and mission- **WE NEED VOLUNTEERS!**

The Gloucester Skating Club will be hosting the Eastern Ontario STARSkate Invitational Championship (EOSIC) which will take place February 19-21, 2010. **This year, more than ever, the Club will need your support and, as such, the volunteer fee has been increased to \$100 and will require a minimum of 15 volunteer hours per family with 6 of those hours to be served during EOSIC (Feb 19-21) and at least 9 additional hours at Spring Fest (Apr 9-11), and/or other Gloucester Skating Club events.** By completing the attached Member Volunteer Form, we hope to match our needs to your volunteer experiences and interests. As you will see, there are many opportunities for your family to fulfill the mandatory hours with volunteer activities that will suit your interests.

WHAT IS A VOLUNTEER FEE? And WHY?

To ensure that the Club can access the resources necessary to support the skaters and the Club's Skater Development and fundraising events, a \$100 post-dated cheque (15 May 2010) will be required with each skater's registration (one per family). This \$100.00 will not be charged to you if you have fulfilled your volunteer hours requirement between September 2009 and May 2010.

- A **Member Volunteer Tracking form** is enclosed with this letter. Once you have completed any volunteer hours, a committee member/Board member signs to verify these hours. When **15 hours are completed (minimum 6 hours to be served during EOSIC)**, please return this tracking form to the office and your post-dated cheque will be returned to you.
- Cheques will not be deposited until the club has confirmed with the families by April 30th that the mandatory 15 volunteer hours have not been completed.

1. You get to contribute to a great organization committed to ensuring your kids have the best skating instruction and development found anywhere.
2. You get to work with great people who are equally committed to making a difference for each and every skater.

SPRING FESTIVAL (9-11 April 2010) And EOSIC COMPETITION (19-21 February 2010)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Various positions required for Spring Festival and EOSIC including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ice Captains; ○ Dressing Room Attendants; ○ Set up and tear down (judge's platforms, etc.); ○ Announcers; ○ Admission and Registration Desk Personnel; ○ Hospitality; ○ Flowers; and ○ Security.
COMPETITIVE OR EOSIC TEAM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Volunteers are required for assisting with both Teams at GSC, activities include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Set up of party room ○ Serve food for party ○ Tidy up room after party ○ Prepare letters for skaters Used Skate and Clothing sale
BANQUET AND AWARDS NIGHT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Held in May/June- help needed to organize, collect for the silent auction, and assist with this special event.
AD HOC REQUESTS	There are various events held at the Club each year that require volunteers, some examples include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club competition (Dec.) • GSC Parade of Lights float (Nov.) • Misc. These events require a minimal number of volunteers.
