



FundScrip - Frequently Asked Questions

What is FundScrip?

Members register with FundScrip and then purchase gift cards from retailers in virtually every category from grocery and gas to department and specialty stores. With each gift card purchase, FundScrip pays a % (ranges from 2% to 15% depending on the retailer) back to you. The Club is pleased to offer our members 100% profit on earnings* – earnings which can be put towards your child's ice fees.

* The Club is in a position to offer 100 % at this time. Should the Club's position change in the future we may have to change the profit-sharing split.

How do I sign-up?

Register online as a supporter – it's free and easy! Follow the instructions at www.fundscrip.com

How do I make purchases?

Purchases can be made electronically from your FundScrip account.

Sign-up for Electronic Fund Transfers – print off the form from the FundScrip web site, complete it, and fax it to FundScrip with a void cheque. Note: Credit Card purchases are also available however, **Electronic purchases are preferred. They cost you nothing and you keep more of your earnings!** Credit card purchases are charged an additional fee of 2.25% and ARE NOT ADVISED!

Payments **cannot** be made from skaters' GSC accounts. If a skater has a credit on their account it cannot be used to purchase cards through FundScrip.

How often can I make purchases?

Purchases can be made every **two weeks**.

Order deadlines are every second Monday at 9:30 am EST (subject to change based on statutory holidays)
An order and delivery calendar is available on the GSC web site under the FundScrip tab.

Where do I pick up my gift cards?

Orders can be picked up from the Club Office Thursdays between 4 and 7 pm. Cards ordered online are delivered to the Club Office Thursday of the same week as the order deadline.

How will I receive my earnings?

GSC will allocate 100% of the earnings to individual members' accounts calculated based on their monthly purchases.

Sample Calculation:

\$800 in monthly purchases X 3% (average card earnings) = **\$24 in earnings applied to your skater's account**
